



## 2021-2022 Naturalization Examination Scholar Results

Beginning with the 2021-2022 school year, Indiana Code 20-30-5-7(d) requires, not later than November 1, 2022, and not later than November 1 each year thereafter, the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) to report student data from the naturalization examination to the Indiana General Assembly. Therefore, school corporations must provide the naturalization examination to scholars completing a U.S. government course and report the results to IDOE.

Each scholar enrolled in a U.S. Government course where credit is awarded for General, Core 40, Core 40 with Academic Honors, or Core 40 with Technical Honors designation is **required** to take the naturalization examination provided by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) as administered by the scholar's high school. U.S. Government courses include Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, dual credit, and Cambridge International courses.
