Prior to that date, we will communicate to our families the pick-up procedures as well as provide information on our online learning platform and expectations. We are open Monday-Friday from 7:30-4:00.

These are challenging times for all of us and we understand that schooling from home is very difficult for our families. Please know that we continue to keep your child in the front of all the decisions we make. We miss all of you so very much and look forward to the day when we can celebrate our children on campus together. Until then, we will do everything we can to support you and your family.

Main Preparatory Academy

Main Preparatory Academy recruits students of any race, color, gender, disability or ethnic origin to all its rights, privileges, programs and activities.
