

COVID-19 POLICIES & PROCEDURES

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and has significant person-to-person spread. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies have recommended social distancing measures and have, in many locations, required ongoing prohibitions on the congregation of groups of people of various sizes.

Before entering the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Flint, all individuals must wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth. Upon entry, individuals will be asked to use hand sanitizer and then will be screened using a touchless thermometer. If the temperature is below 100.3 degrees, the individual will be permitted into the building. If the temperature is at or above 100.3 degrees, the individual will be asked to leave the premises.

Social distancing practices will be implemented and enforced to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Individuals will be asked to use hand sanitizer or wash hands at an increased rate. The Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Flint will sanitize highly touched surfaces frequently. There will be a spray system used to sanitize the building regularly.

If an individual becomes ill or displays symptoms of illness, they will be quarantined in a designated space and their parent/guardian will be called to pick them up immediately.

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Flint maintain safety as its top priority and will utilize the proper measures to sanitize and keep members, staff, and volunteers safe.
