Our School Improvement Plan (ACIP) Explained for Families

At Davis Elementary, we want every child to grow academically, socially, and emotionally. As part of our commitment to student success, we have created a School Improvement Plan, known as our ACIP. This plan explains the goals we are working toward this year and the steps we are taking to make Davis Elementary even stronger.

Below is a simple explanation of our school improvement goals.

1. Improving Reading Achievement

Goal

Increase the number of students who score proficient in Reading/ELA on the state report card from 19% to 24%.

How we plan to do this

- Analyze student performance data more consistently
- Identify learning gaps earlier
- Adjust instruction based on student needs
- Use targeted reading interventions, including:
 - Open Court
 - o mClass
 - Small-group instruction

How we will measure progress

- ACAP state test data
- Monthly iReady data

2. Increasing Student Academic Growth

Goal

Increase Academic Growth on the school report card from 80.74% to 86.74%.

How we plan to do this

- Use a comprehensive academic support system to monitor student progress
- Use Pear Assess to track how well students are learning grade-level standards
- Provide interventions based on individual needs

How we will measure progress

- ACAP
- iReady

This means we're working to ensure every student shows growth, not just proficiency.

3. Improving Math Achievement

Goal

Increase the number of students who score proficient in Math from 9% to 14%.

How we plan to do this

- Provide daily small-group instruction
- Closely monitor student progress
- Offer targeted math interventions
- Use student data to adjust instruction immediately

How we will measure progress

- ACAP
- iReady

4. Improving Attendance & School Culture

We know students do better academically when they attend school regularly and feel connected.

Goal

Reduce chronic absenteeism from 27.48% to 17.48%.

How we plan to do this


- Provide attendance rewards and recognition
- Create exciting clubs and extracurricular activities
- Strengthen student organizations
- Improve student engagement and motivation
- Use LiveSchool to track behavior and celebrate positive actions

How we will measure progress

- Daily PowerSchool attendance reports
- Weekly SWAT and data reviews
