Title I Budget Explained for Families

Title I funds are federal dollars that help our school support students academically—especially those who need additional help in reading, math, and foundational learning skills.

For the 2025-2026 school year, Davis Elementary was allocated approximately \$250,560 in Title I base funding and \$3,893 for family engagement activities.

These funds allow us to provide MORE support to students, teachers, and families.

Below is a simple explanation of where the money goes and how it directly supports students.



How Title I Funds Will Be Used at Davis Elementary

1. Additional Classroom Support Staff

A large portion of our Title I funding will be used to pay for:

- ✓ Instructional Paraprofessionals (classroom instructional assistants)

- ✓ A school counselor (partial salary)
- ✓ A Title I Assistant Principal (partial salary)

These team members help our school by:

- providing one-on-one and small-group support
- working with students who struggle academically
- supporting social-emotional needs
- leading tutoring interventions
- helping teachers analyze student data
- monitoring attendance and family needs

This allows MORE adult support for K–5 students to help them succeed academically and emotionally.



Classroom Materials & Technology

Title I will fund:

- ✓ classroom learning materials
- ✓ manipulatives (math hands-on tools)
- ✓ supplies for small group instruction
- ✓ Smart Boards and classroom technology for teaching

These materials help teachers deliver effective lessons and give students what they need to learn successfully.



Technology for Instruction & Data

The budget includes funds for:

- ✓ Smart Boards
- ✓ instructional presentation equipment

These tools help teachers:

- teach whole-class lessons more effectively
- monitor student progress
- analyze data to support each child

This ensures instruction is targeted, visual, and engaging.



Parent & Family Programs

Funding is also dedicated to:

- ✓ Math Night materials
- ✓ Literacy Night materials
- ✓ parent learning resources
- ✓ communication materials

These events help parents learn how to support learning at home and build strong school-family partnerships.



What Title I Does Not Pay For

These funds do not cover:

- ✗ school construction
- ✗ student rewards
- ✗ clubs
- ✗ sports
- ✗ school trips (outside instruction)
- ✗ regular teacher salaries
- ✗ food for staff

Funds must support academic achievement and family engagement.
