Thank you for being a part of Greater Heights Academy! As you know, our top priority for the 2020-2021 school year has been to ensure the safety of scholars, staff, and families. We implemented strong plans to support that effort including smaller classroom sizes, social distancing, temperature checks, revised dismissal and drop-off procedures, and providing protective equipment to staff and scholars. Unfortunately, the surge of cases in Genesee County coupled with the risk of transmission over the holidays requires that we elevate safety precautions for our staff, students, and families. Our school building will be closed, and in-person instruction will be suspended for the remainder of the calendar year.

All instruction will be shifting to fully virtual after Thanksgiving Break with an anticipated return date of January 19, 2021. Though our building will close, we are proud that we have provided our scholars with the tools and resources needed for high-quality learning to continue. We will still deliver live virtual instruction Monday-Friday using our online learning platform, Blackboard. In addition, we are going to continue to support our scholars with our supplemental food program. Food distribution will continue to take place every Wednesday through direct delivery! Please make sure the address we have on file at the school is the correct address for food and material deliveries.

Greater Heights Academy will continue to keep families in our thoughts. We will continue to provide support in various ways as we try to overcome the challenges of this pandemic together.
