## POLICES TO REMEMBER

### **Uniform Policy**

Eagle's Nest Academy is a uniform school, this means all scholars are required to wear a school uniform. The first date for scholars to be in uniform is September 5, 2023. Scholars are required to wear navy or khaki bottoms and white or navy tops. Uniforms are required Monday - Wednesday. Scholars may wear a uniform shirt or Eagle's Nest Academy T-shirt with jeans on Thursdays and Fridays. Complete dress down days will be announced for special occasions, ONLY.

### **Attendance Policy**

Attending school daily is very important. It is difficult for scholars to learn when they are not in school. This year we will be enforcing our attendance policy. Our goal is to remove attendance barriers that you may experience, please contact the school if your child will be absent or late. If absences are excessive, more than one absent a month, the academy is required to follow procedures up to filing educational neglect.
